- (1) & (2) After considerable discussion and a visit to the site, the following sequence of moves and allocation of space were agreed.

Building 33

Library to move from Room G.15 to G.9 and 10 immediately. Cyclotron Group to move into G.15. The Ministry of Works to be requested to expedite completion of one room in 154 as office for Mr. Duke. Cyclotron Group then to expand into G.14. Library to move to building 161 when allotted rooms have been cleaned and minor alterations carried out.

Ministry of Works to be requested to convert Rooms G.7, 8, 9, and 10 into offices with additional new windows and fluorescent lighting.

Cyclotron Group to move into G.7, 8, 9 on completion of alterations.

Theoretical Physics Group to take over G.12 and 13 on vacation of Library and expand into G.14 and 15 on vacation by Cyclotron Group as above. Dr. London to move his workshop from G.11 to G.19 and provide storage space for 10' x 5' model Cyclotron.

Neutrometry Group to move from Rooms 32 and 35 to Building 161 and rooms to be taken over by Theoretical Physics.

When Dr. Dawton has moved to 154, room to be taken over by Theoretical Physics.
