

How to get the best use from your telephone

1. List on the back cover of this directory, your own index of frequently called numbers. Keep your list up-to-date.
2. Keep a message pad by your telephone.
3. Answer telephone calls promptly—it helps take the pressure off your operator and saves callers time and money.
4. Always identify yourself by name, extension or department to let your caller know he has the right connection.
5. Learn how to use the enquiry, transfer and recall facilities as detailed on page 5.
6. Quote your extension number on all correspondence, also STD number (0235).
7. Plan your outgoing calls in advance. List points you wish to make or the information you need.
8. If you are calling a switchboard and the extension you require is engaged, there may be an alternative number or person who can help. If not, it is cheaper to phone again than hold on for a long time. Better still, invite them to ring you back.
9. Try to cultivate economy on the telephone. Time wasted on the telephone is money wasted.

Trunk calls are cheaper after mid-day.

Advice on using the telephone or telex system is available from the supervisor on Extension 2260.

The telex service is still the cheapest form of telecommunication offering speedy transmission of typed-text on a world-wide network. See page 5.

Dialling tones

Dialling tone (a continuous purring)
means that the exchange equipment is ready for you to start dialling. Don't dial before you hear this tone or you may get a wrong number.

Ringling tone (a repeated burr-burr)
means that the called number is being rung. Allow a reasonable time for an answer, if there is no reply replace the receiver and try again later.

Engaged tone (a repeated single note)
means that the number you are calling is in use. Replace the receiver and try again in about five minutes.

Number unobtainable tone (a steady note)
means that the number you have obtained is either out of service or spare. Check that you are using the correct code and number and then try again. If you again hear the tone call the Post Office operator if the number you require is external, and explain what has happened. If the number you dialled is internal ring Extension 191 (Telephone Enquiries).

Equipment engaged tone (an alternate long and short note) (internal calls only)
means that the equipment to the area of the number called is engaged. Replace your receiver and try again in five minutes.

Operator's interruption tone (repeated pips)
If you are engaged on a call and an incoming call is received for your extension, the pips will occur when the Harwell operator interrupts your conversation to warn you that another call is waiting.

Official Calls

90 (Unbarred) Telephones

Trunk calls
Dialling codes are listed in the Harwell booklet 'TRUNK & LOCAL DIALLING CODES' and may be dialled direct. If the exchange required is not listed dial 93-100 and pass the exchange and number to the Oxford exchange operator, identifying yourself as 'OXFORD TRUNK SUB 41'. If the call has to be booked you will need to declare your site extension number to the Oxford operator.

Overseas calls

Dial 90 and pass the details to the Harwell operator.

10 (Barred) Telephones

Trunk calls

Dial 10 and book the call through the Harwell operator giving number required, your name and extension.

Dial 3030 during silent hours.

Overseas calls

Dial 10 and pass the details to the Harwell operator.

Local calls and private wires

Dialling codes for local exchanges are listed on page 1 of this Telephone Directory. Private wires are on page 3.

Reversed charge calls

Because of the difficulty of ensuring that incoming reversed charge calls are official they can normally be accepted only by prior arrangement with the Telephone Supervisor (Extn. 2260).

Private Calls

The dialling codes for official trunk and local calls commencing 14, 92, 93 or 94 must not be used for any private calls

90 (Unbarred) Telephones

Trunk calls
Dial 90 and pass details to the Harwell operator. The call MUST be declared as private in advance. Dial 3030 during silent hours.

10 (Barred) Telephones

Trunk calls

Dial 10 and pass details to the Harwell operator. The call MUST be declared as private in advance. Dial 3030 during silent hours.

Local calls

Dial 13 and pass the number required to the Abingdon operator. Local exchanges available are listed on page 1 of the Harwell Telephone Directory. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY ANY OTHER ROUTE BE USED FOR PRIVATE LOCAL CALLS.

The use of the site telephone system for making private internal or external calls is a concession available to all staff but, in order to relieve pressure on the system and improve the service for official business, staff are requested to make private local or operator-connected private trunk calls only in the following three periods, and to discourage incoming private calls outside these periods:

- (i) Before 10 a.m.
 - (ii) Between noon and 2 p.m.
 - (iii) After 4 p.m.
- } For private local calls

Private incoming calls to HARWELL

Staff who receive private incoming calls are asked to note and publicise **DIDCOT 2501** as the route for these calls. Abingdon 4141 should NOT be used for private calls.

Economy in telephone use

Any outgoing call may be monitored to ensure that the telephone system is being used in the best interest of HARWELL. Calls declared as private in advance are not monitored.

Use of Enquiry, Transfer and Recall Facilities

On all telephones there is a button marked 'PRESS' or 'RECALL'. This is for use with EXTERNAL CALLS ONLY, on either exchange lines or private wires, and enables the user either:

To transfer call to another extension

- (i) Press 'RECALL' button and wait for dialling tone
- (ii) Dial extension required
- (iii) When extension answers announce name of caller and replace receiver.

To make enquiry of another extension

- (i) Press 'RECALL' button and wait for dialling tone
- (ii) Dial extension required
- (iii) Make enquiry and revert to caller by pressing 'RECALL' button again

To recall operator

- (i) Press 'RECALL' button and wait for dialling tone
- (ii) Dial operator
- (iii) Replace receiver if the operator is taking the call

Notes

- 1 If the dialling tone is not heard when recall button is pressed and released, this means that all available circuits are engaged. Depress recall button again to re-connect the caller.
- 2 If extension is engaged, depress button again to reconnect to the caller.
- 3 Whilst the enquiry is being made the original caller cannot hear your conversation.
- 4 If you 'lose' a transfer call by mishandling it may revert automatically to the HARWELL operator.

Telex Service

A Telex service is available in Building 77. This service provides a rapid and economical method of sending written messages to subscribers in this country and overseas.

Messages intended for Telex should be written in BLOCK CAPITALS and sent to 'TELEX, BLDG. 77'. Urgent short messages may be telephoned to the Telex operator on Extension 2749. Every effort will be made to transmit on the same day messages received in the Telex office before 4 p.m. Monday-Thursday inclusive and before 3 p.m. on Fridays. A confirmation copy of the outgoing Telex will be sent to the originator.

Routine incoming Telex messages are normally delivered by the site mail service, but priority messages may be telephoned or delivered by special messenger.

Further information about the Telex service may be obtained from the Telex operator on Extension 2749.

Facsimile Service

A facsimile machine is available in the Telex Room, Building 77 for transmitting and receiving manuscripts, charts, diagrams, etc. (maximum size 9in. x 13in). Other Authority facsimile machine users are London Office, Risley, Culcheth, Downrey and Wirrith. Details of this service are available from the Telex operator, Extn. 2749.

Conference Facility

The Conference facility enables a total of up to five lines (including Harwell site extensions) to be inter-connected.

Staff wishing to book this facility should ring the Telephone Supervisor on Extension 2260 giving all necessary details.
