RADIATION PROTECTION AT THE RUTHERFORD LABORATORY

1. The National Institute is responsible for the control of radiation hazards at the Rutherford Laboratory.
2. Mr. M. Snowden has been appointed on a part-time basis to be responsible to the Director of the Rutherford Laboratory for health monitoring and radiation protection.
3. A small Radiation Protection Group has been started by Mr. Snowden. Within this Group Mr. W. Burrells will operate a Radiation Monitoring Service for the Rutherford Laboratory with the following duties.
 - (a) Issue and collection of film badges.
 - (b) Survey of site and laboratories.
 - (c) Register of radiation sources.
 - (d) Instrument loan and calibration.
 - (e) Health records.
4. The Accelerator Division and National Institute Safety Committee has recently extended its terms of reference to include Radiation Safety and the Radiation Protection Group now has representation on this Committee. Problems on radiation, however, should be referred direct to the Radiation Protection Group.
5. Health Physics Division, A.E.R.E. continue to act as advisers to the National Institute and the control of hazards affecting both A.E.R.E. and the National Institute are handled jointly.
