Sale of Land at A.E.R.E. to N.I.R.N.S.

Sometime ago you mentioned to me that you wished to have reserved for various Authority services a strip of land on the N.I.R.N.S. site near the Dido Road. The map you gave me then, and which I enclose herewith, shows the suggested strip hatched in pencil and having a width of between 10 and 20 ft.

I have discussed the matter briefly with Dr. J. A. V. Willis and he considers that the simplest way of settling the details of our requirements would be for you to get in touch direct with Mr. P. Bowles. Would you please do this and let me know in due course for which services the National Institute are prepared to grant us an easement.
